Summary

This is an exciting opportunity to join the Equivalital team, working for a world leader in professional wearable technology solutions. As the UX designer within the Equivalital Product Management team you will be working primarily on the Black Ghost product. Black Ghost is an end to end system of body worn sensors that communicate with a web software application to visualise real time physiological and location data, communicate alert states and predict human health and safety conditions. The product includes web, desktop and mobile software, APIs and a body area network of sensors.

As the UX designer you will collaborate with product managers to understand detailed requirements and design complete user experiences that meet the product vision and solve the market problem. You will be an expert in information architecture and visual design. You will be the lead on usability testing and feedback results to product management.

You can expect to work closely with the development team including the UI developer and product owner to iterate and implement final visual designs.

- Translating concepts into user flows, wireframes, mockups and prototypes that lead to intuitive user experiences
- Taking a user centred design approach and rapidly test and iterate your designs
- Identifying design problems and devise elegant solutions
- Facilitating the product vision by researching, prototyping and user testing experiences
- Collaborating effectively with team members and stakeholders to understand constraints on design for example cost effectiveness, time to market, technical limitations



What you need to have

- Three or more years of UX design experience.
- Expertise in standard UX software such as Sketch, Axure, InVision, Adobe XD and the like is a must. Basic HTML5, CSS3, and JavaScript skills are a plus.
- Extensive experience in using UX design best practices to design solutions, and a deep understanding of responsive design.
- A solid grasp of user-centred design (UCD), planning and conducting user research, user testing, A/B testing, rapid prototyping and usability
- Ability to work effectively in a team setting including synthesizing abstract ideas into concrete design implications.
